Hebrews is one of the Bible's most captivating books. Authorship remains a mystery but the point of the book is clearevery chapter focuses on the amazing work of Jesus Christ. I struggled for weeks trying to illustrate this complicated book for The Picture-Smart Bible (I would like to give it one more try). Chapter 4 challenges us to examine the subject of "REST."Rest is a very elusive for most Americans (me included). I try to honor the Sabbath rest because I know Father knows best- my bod needs rest. God required rest for humans, animals and the land, and we violate that command to our own destruction. In closer examination, the "rest" in Hebrews 4 doesn't necessarily involve inactivity. Rest is part of "the gospel" mentioned in 4:2, "For indeed the gospel was preached to us as well as to them (Israel)."

## End of the Fix-it Man

Question: What did the early Hebrews know about Jesus? On the way to Emmaus (Lk. 24:27), Jesus gave a stunning revelation, "Beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in **all the Scriptures** the things concerning Himself." (Emphasis mine). That statement prompted the "Good News Starburst"- a symbol reflected in every TPSB Old Testament drawing.

Examples which Jesus may have included: God warned Satan of the Messiah's victory (Gen. 3:15), Abraham met Melchizedek (preappearance of Jesus), Moses was hidden in the cleft of the Rock (Ex. 33:22, I Cor 10:4), David often became the voice of the Messiah, the prophets continually pointed to the good news of Jesus Christ. The Hebrew writer implies that the Hebrews had no excuse regarding ignorance of the gospel; their problem was not a lack of the good news, it was a lack of faith. Their problem and ours is lack of genuine trust that God will take care of us.

Our unrest and worry is not His fault but ours. In places of trial, such as a convention that is not going well through lack of attendance, as I sit behind the table at our booth, I have a choice:

I can worry (and share my woes with worried fellow vendors), or I can rejoice; not a fake smile, but a true joy based on my trust that He WILL take care of me.

A year ago, in one of our most discouraging conventions, two miracles happened: a lady handed us a donation that offset much of our loss in the event, and Abhijit Nayak made the contact which God is using to send The Picture-Smart Bible to India.

I am a hopeless "Fix-it Man"...whether it be a faulty faucet or a ruptured relationship. I need my Father for both, but for sure I need to pray and let Him fix relationships. I mean, **let go and let God!** Even with my miserable record of making ruptured relationships worse, I still struggle with taking my hands off the steering wheel. The Hebrew writer concludes the section on rest with, "There **remains therefore a rest** for the people of God...let us therefore be diligent to enter that rest, lest anyone fall according to the same example of disobedience" (Heb. 4:9, 11). It's an oxymoron, but we have to work at entering His rest. We really have no choice, so hang up your tool apron.
